## ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION NONPROFIT CORPORATION

ARTICLE 1: Name of the corporation:

OREGON CENTER FOR PUBLIC POLICY

ARTICLE 2: Type of Corporation is: PUBLIC BENEFIT

ARTICLE 5: The corporation will not have members.

ARTICLE 6: Distribution of assets on Dissolution or Final Liquidation:

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of \$501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the court of appropriate jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as that court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

ARTICLE 7: Name and address of each director: SEE ATTACHMENT A

ARTICLE 8: Each director has consented to this appointment.

ARTICLE 9: Additional provisions:

1. This corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, literary, or scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to such organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

- No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, directors, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes of this corporation. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 or the corresponding section of any future federal tax or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under \$170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
- 3. This corporation shall indemnify its officers and directors to the full extent allowed by law.
- 4. The personal liability of the directors and officers of this corporation to this corporation for conduct as an officer or director shall be eliminated or limited to the full extent allowed by law.
